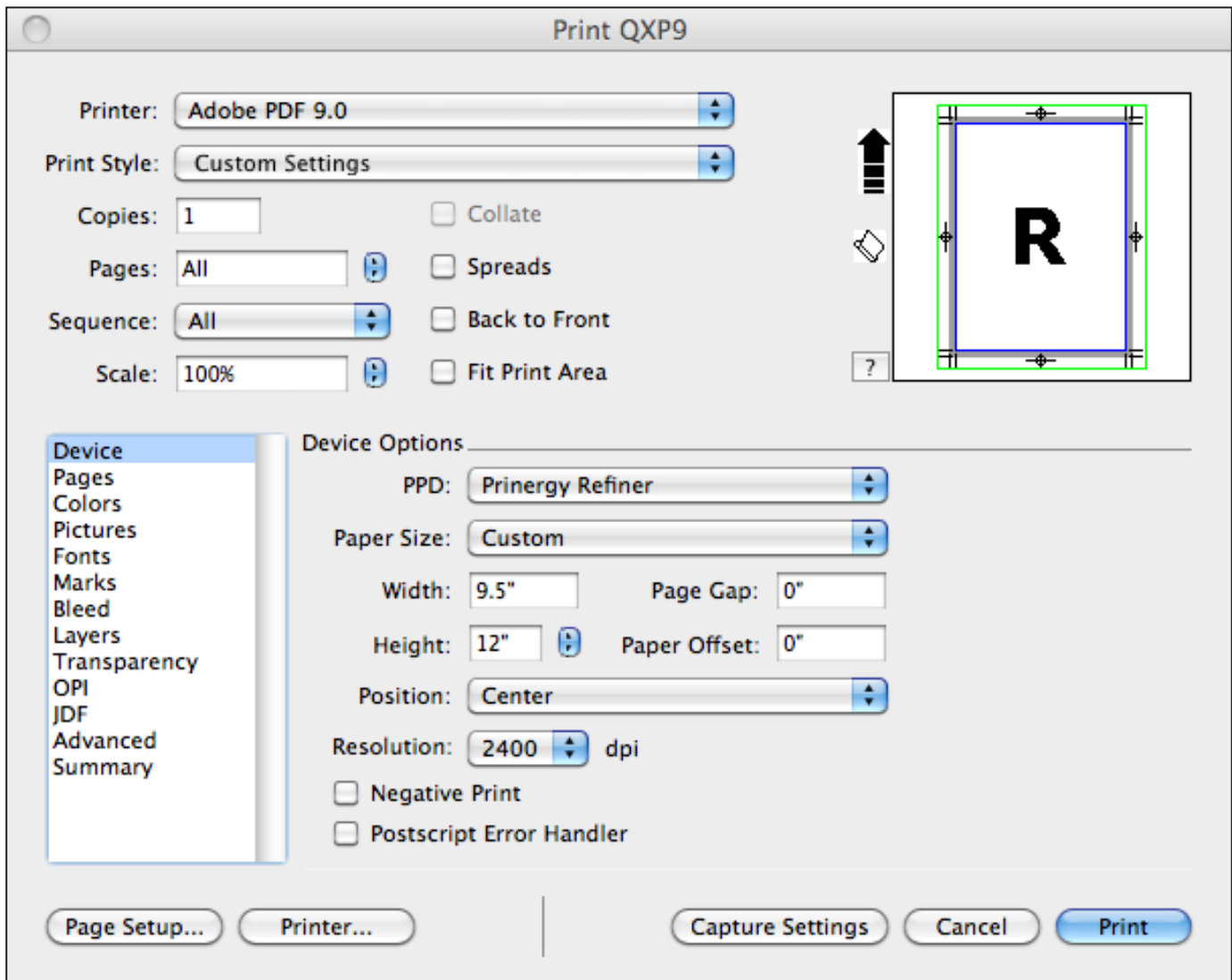

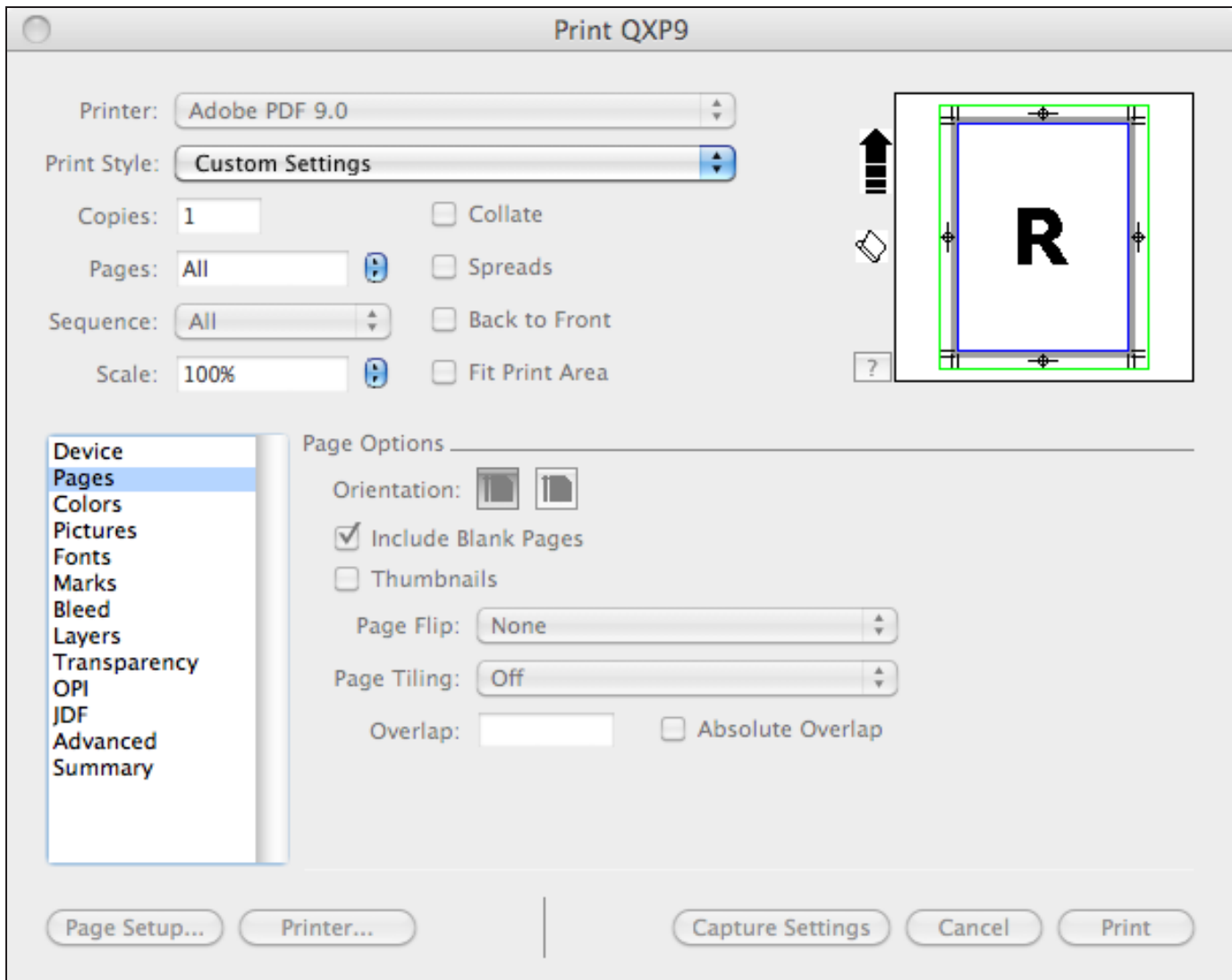
Step 1



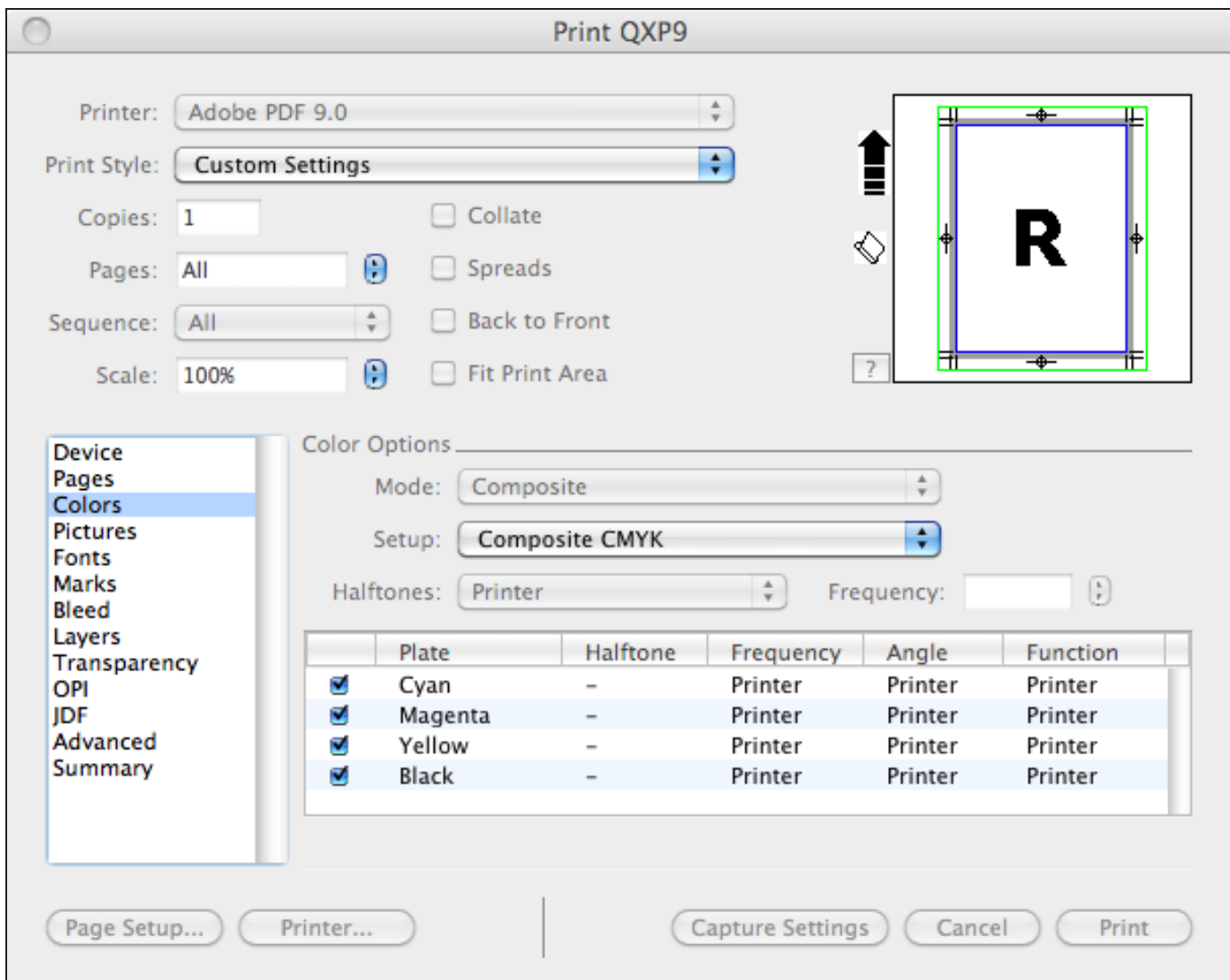
Add one inch to Width and Height fields as seen above. Above example is based on 8.5 x 11 trim size. Please ensure to select "Prinerigy Refiner" as the PPD. The Prinerigy Refiner PPD can be downloaded from <http://www.rightfromthestart.com>.

The above example shows Adobe PDF 9.0 as the target printer. Version 6, 7 or 8 will work as well.

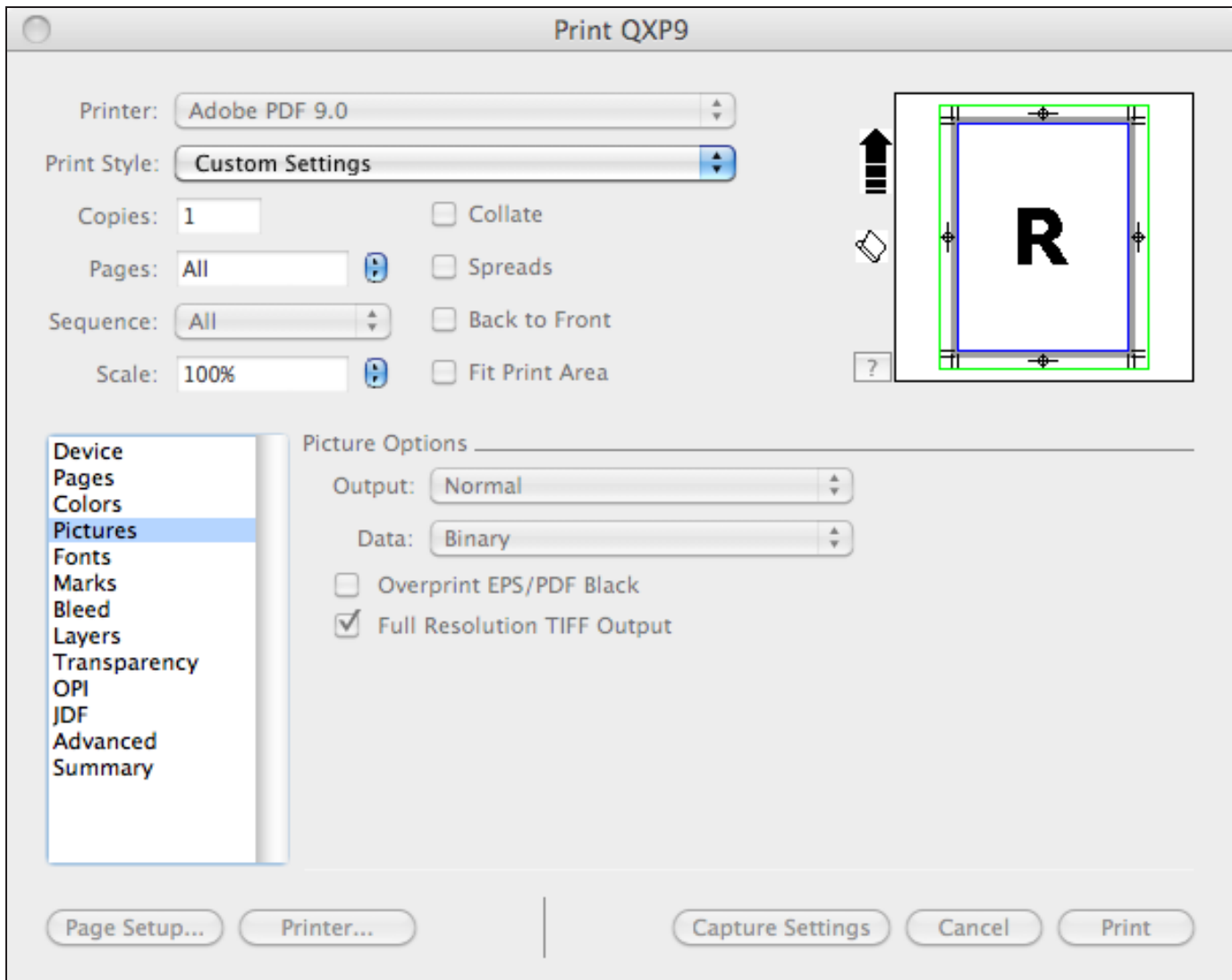

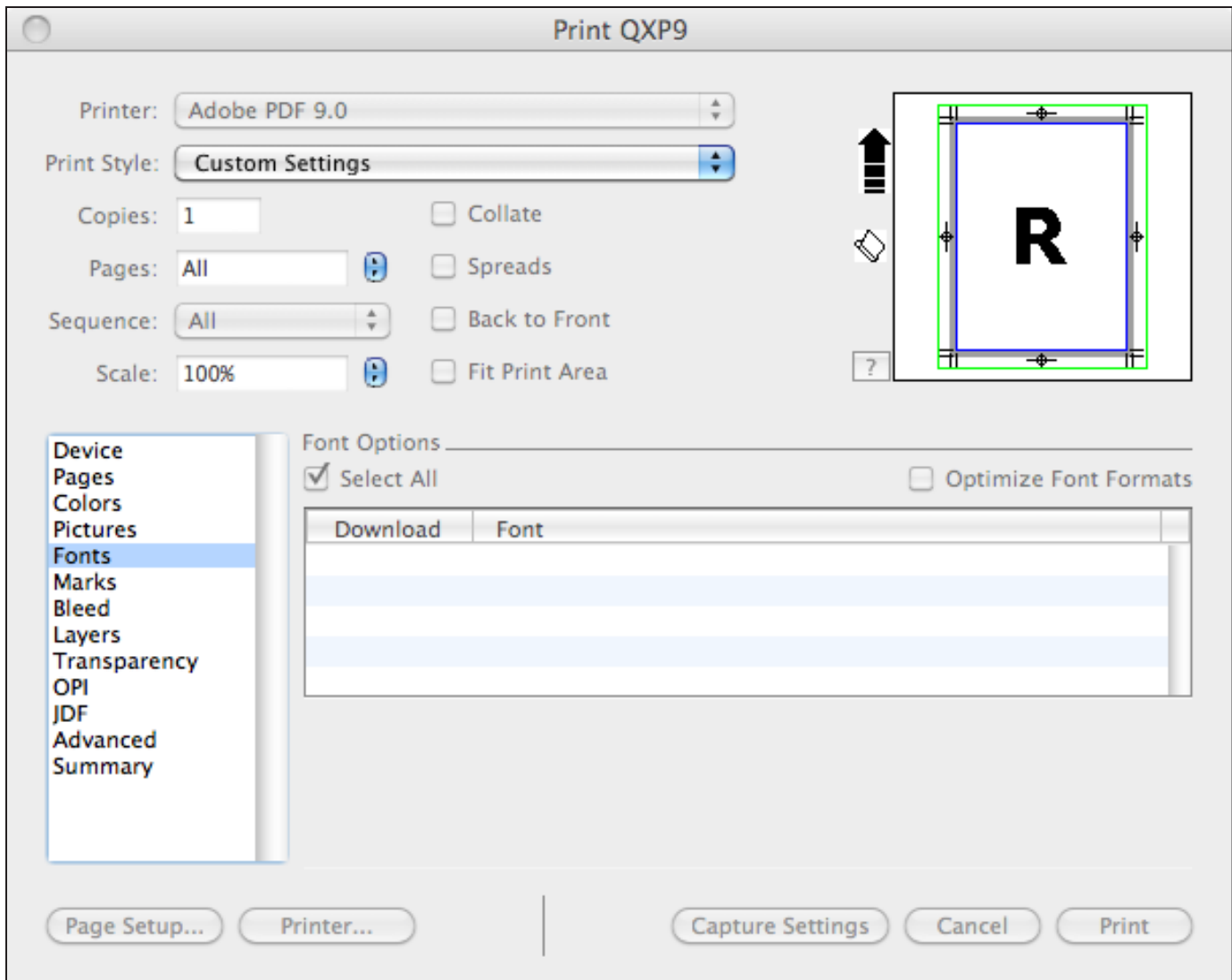


Above example is based four-color process job.

For black only jobs, please select "Grayscale".

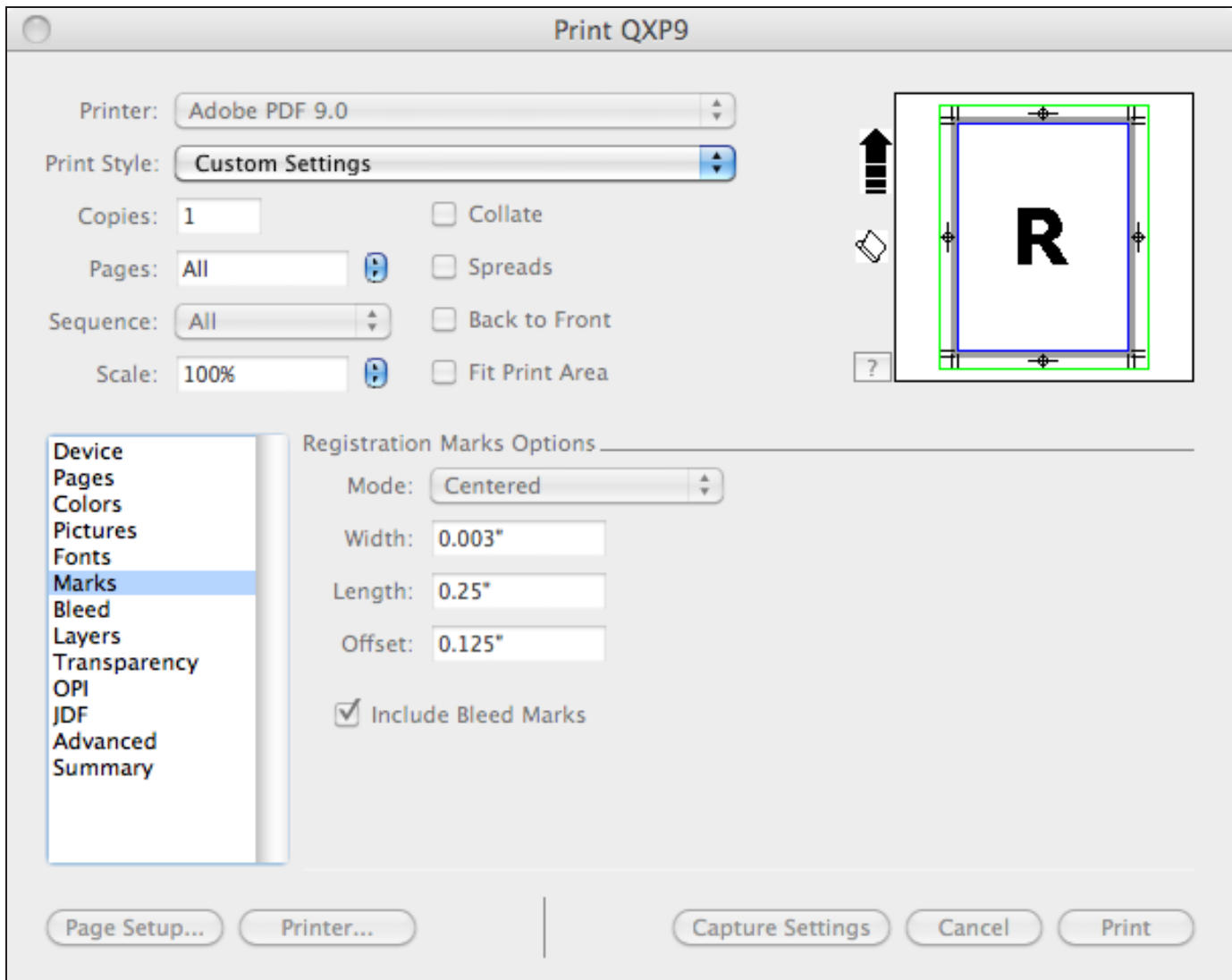

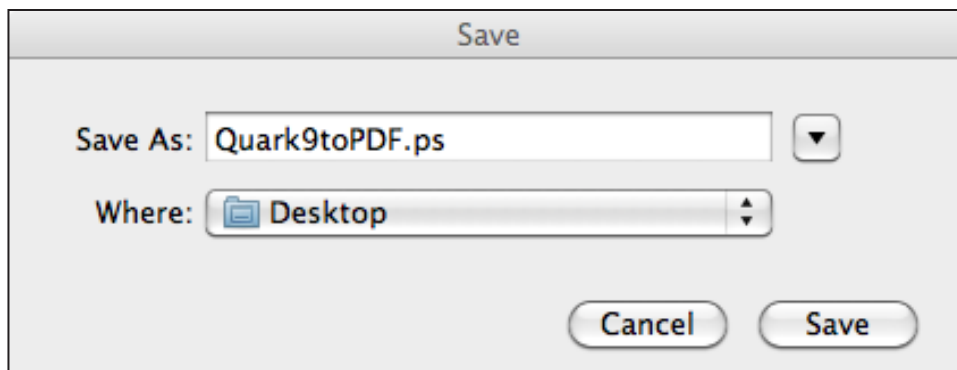
Once PostScript Level 3 is selected from the PostScript Level pull-down menu, please click on the Printer button circled above.

Step 13



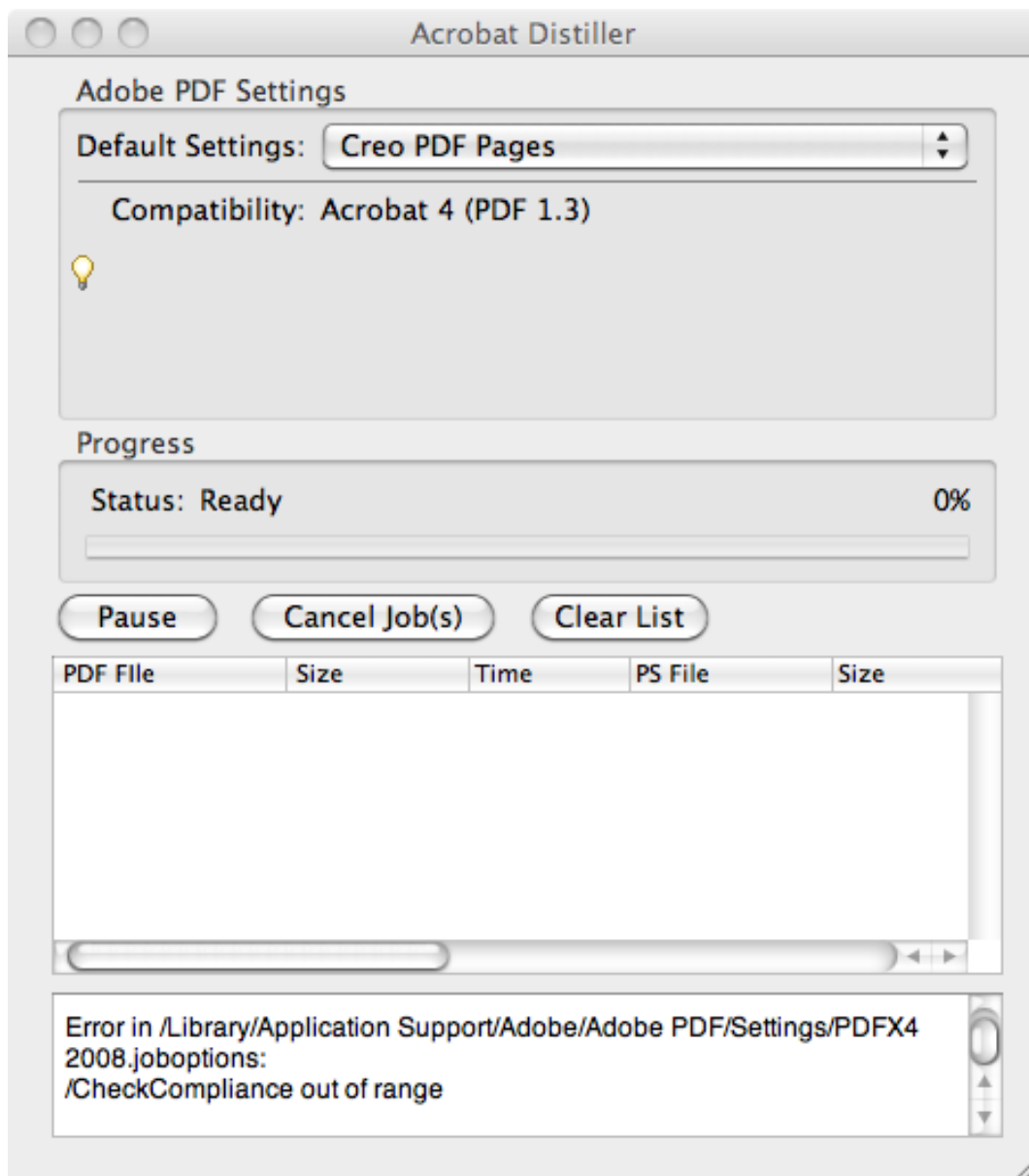
Click the PDF button circled above and select "Save as PostScript".
