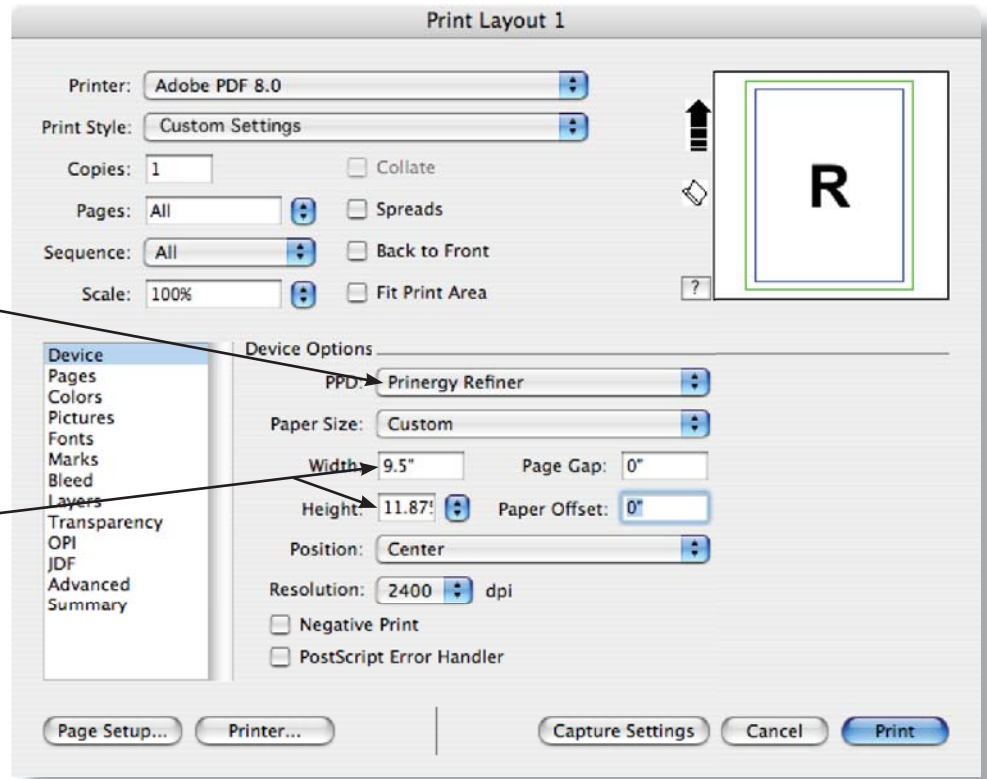


How to create a postscript file from Quark 7

1. Device

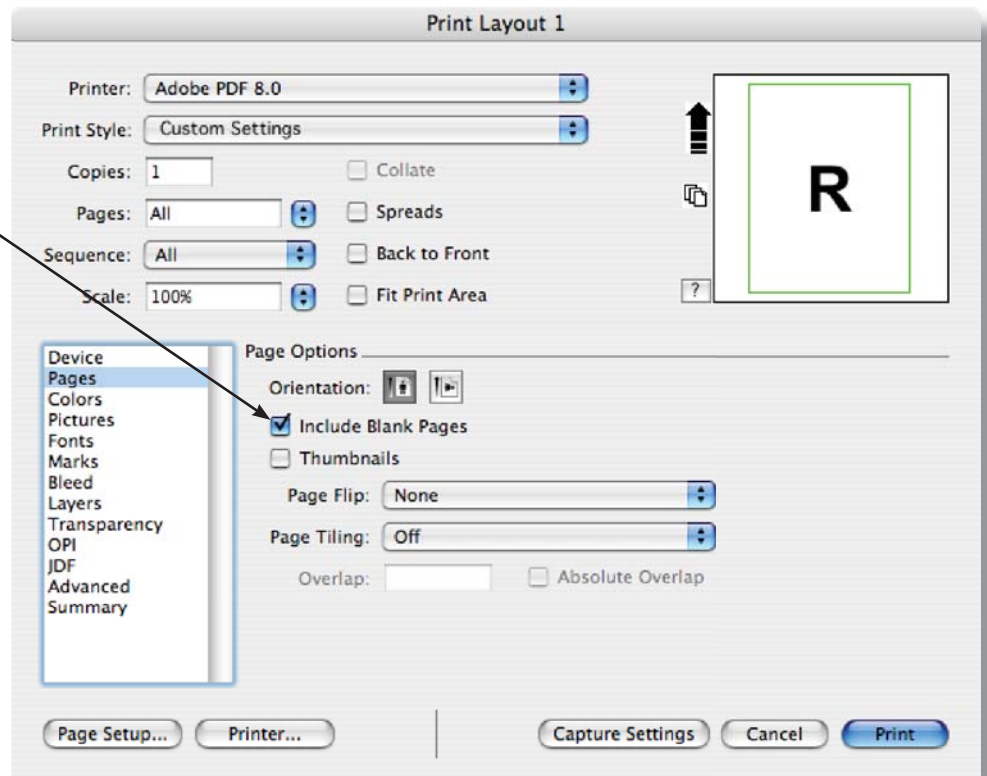
Under Device you will need to use the “Prinergy Refiner” PPD which can be found on our website at www.rightfromthestart.com.

Please set your width and height to 1” larger than your trim size. This will allow for all the marks that will be needed. This example is for a trim size of 8.5 x 10.875.



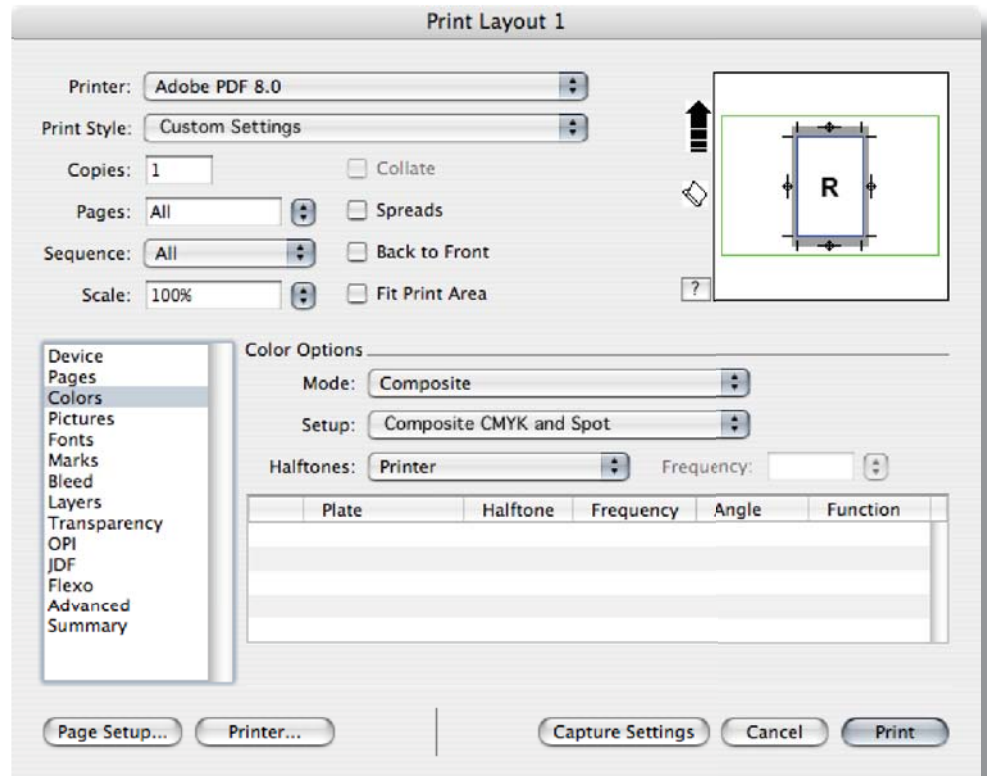
2. Pages

Only include blank pages if you built the blanks into your project.

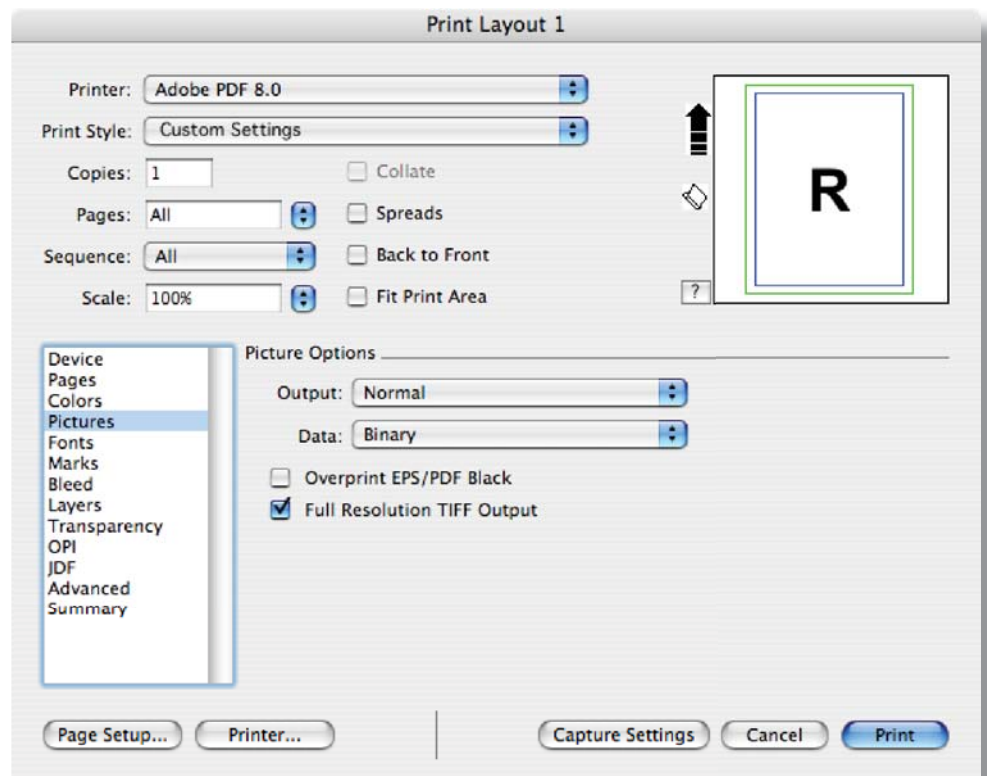

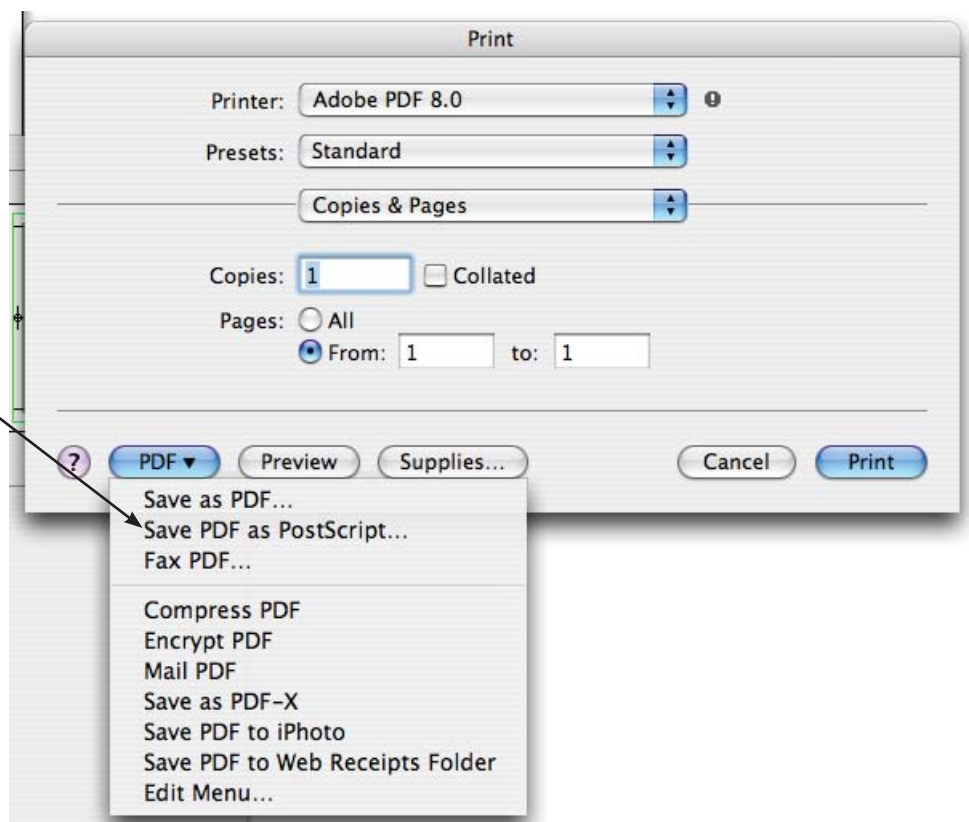
12. Printer

After you have entered all your settings now it is time to create your postscript file. Click on "Printer".



13. Save to Postscript

You will see this window after you click "Printer". You will need to click "Save PDF as Postscript". After this you will be prompted to name and save your postscript file.



When the postscript file is saved you will need to use Acrobat Distiller to create your PDF. The distiller settings can be found on our website at www.rightfromthestart.com.
